Admission to colleges/Institutions Affiliated to Punjabi University, Patiala.

Punjabi University, Patiala is one of the premier institutions of higher education in northern India. Although originally the university was conceived to develop and promote the Punjabi language, literature and culture, it has since evolved into a multi-faceted and multi-faculty institutions with over fifty-five teaching and research departments, with each department dedicated to excellence in its respective field, producing scholars and professionals of repute.

The university has a modern and well-planned campus located in a sprawling stretch of 320 acres with imposing buildings in a lush-green and pollution-free environment, 7 kilometers away from the din of the city. It has the privilege of having one of the most experienced faculties and best equipped departments and student facilities. All the departments are computerized and networked with the central computer centre through optical fiber network. The central library is stocked with over 4 lakhs books, subscribes to several hundred journals, has air-conditioned reading halls and seating capacity for 400 readers.

In its pursuit of spreading the light of education, the university has established regional/Neighbourhood centres/campuses at Talwandi Sabo, Bathinda, Malerkotla, Mohali, Andretta (H.P.), Rampur Phul, Dehlan Shian, Jhunir, Jaito, Dera Baba Jogi Pir Ralla, Karandi, Sardulgarh and Dehradun, where various programmes of the university are available. The university campus is always abuzz with scholar activities where workshops and seminar of state, national and international levels are held regularly. Along with excellence in academics, the university lays emphasis on overall development of personality and encourages co-curricular and sports activities. It boasts of well-developed sports facilities with a large gymnasium and an in-campus velodrome.

A central placement cell has been established by the university for coordinating training, final placements, guest lectures and industrial visits for its students. The cell remains in constant touch with professional and industrial houses and arranges on and off-campus interviews of its students, highlighting their achievements and potential for delivering goods and hence, playing an important role in their placements.

I University College of Engineering (UCoE)

Eligibility Criteria

Candidates who have passed 10+2 or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and English subjects, will be admitted on the basis of their merit in CET-2009[conducted by Punjab Technical

University(PTU), Jalandhar]/AIEEE-2009 as per counseling schedule of CET-2009 for all categories other than NRI category.

Admission of NRI candidates will be based on merit in 10+2 (Non-Medical) or equivalent examination. Candidates seeking admission under this category should contact the Head, University College of Engineering for further details such as eligibility conditions, last date of application, procedure, counseling schedule etc.

The candidates must declare their claim for reserved categories at the time of filling their forms for the entrance test, otherwise, their subsequent claims may not be accepted at a later stage.

Note : The Candidates seeking admission under sports quota should report with all necessary original documents in the office of Head, University College of Engineering, Punjabi University, Patiala at 10.00 a.m. three days prior to the date fixed for counseling of Sports Category in the counseling schedule given in the information brochure, failing which they will not be considered under sports quota. If there are further rounds of counseling then those who have already reported, in the office of Head, University College of Engineering, Punjabi University, Patiala, three days before the previous counseling need not have to report again.

If a candidate is admitted under NRI category and later on he/she is admitted under the categories other than the above mentioned, all the dues paid by him/her will be adjusted except tuition fee, which will not be refunded. Students coming from SAARC countries shall pay the same amount of fee as paid by the Indian students.

Residents of the hostel, where co-operative mess is being run or those joining co-operative mess, shall have to pay Rs. 1000/- in advance as mess bill. This amount is refunded/adjustable as and when student leaves the hostel or the mess is closed permanently.

All Collections/transfers/refund of fee shall be as per University Rules.

II YADAVINDRA COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING, TALWANDI SABO (YCoE)

(a) Eligibility Criteria

Candidates who have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and English subjects, will be admitted on the basis of their merit in CET-2009 conducted by Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar as per counseling schedule of CET-2009 at Jalandhar for all categories other than NRI category.

Admissions of NRI candidates will be based on merit in 10+2 (Non-Medical) or equivalent examination. Candidates seeking admission under this category should contact the Head, University College of Engineering for further details such as eligibility conditions, last date of application, procedure, counseling schedule etc.

(b) Mode of Admission

Admission to all the B.Tech. courses will be made from the categories described below as per merit list in the following order of preference:

1st Category:

(i) The Candidates must have passed 10+2 (Non-Medical) examination from such a rural area school which does not fall under any Municipal Corporation/Municipal Committee/Small Town/Notified area and where fee/charges are not more than Rs. 600/- per annum.

(ii) The candidate must have been a student of a rural area school as at Sr. No. (i) from 6th till matriculation and total period of study from a school in the rural area should be at least eight years.

(iii) The parents of the candidates must also be the residents of the village.

2nd Category

(i) The candidates must have passed 10+2 (Non-Medical) examination from such a rural area school, which does not fall under any Municipal Corporation/Municipal Committee/Small Town/Notified area.

ii) The candidate must have been a student of the rural area school for at least eight years before the last examination passed.

(iii) The parents of the candidates must also be the residents of the village.

The candidates must deposit a certificate from the concerned Tehsildar/Panchayat regarding above facts. 100% verification will be made by the University. In case the certificate submitted by the candidate is found wrong, all fee/charges deposited by the candidate will be forfeited and the admission will be cancelled. Such candidates will not be admitted in the University or any of the colleges affiliated with the University.

Besides this, the name of the student will be conveyed to UGC/AIW so that such a student be declared ineligible for any other course.

3rd Category :

The candidates fulfilling the eligibility requirements belonging to the rural/urban area.

Admissions will be made according to first category. If seats still remain vacant, the admission will be made from 2nd Category. In case seats still remain vacant the seats will be made open to 3rd Category. The Policy of de-reservation of PTU adopted for central counseling will be followed.

GOLDEN HEARTS SCHEME OF LOAN SCHOLARSHIPS

(Applicable to Yadavindra College of Engineering, Talwandi Sabo only)

Punjabi University, Patiala in its pioneering attempt is making efforts to raise interest-free loan/scholarships for students belonging to rural poor families through benevolent donors and institutions. Many individuals and institutions have come forward for the same. To determine the eligibility for the scholarship, the following criteria will be adopted.

- a) The parents of the candidate should be residents of rural area.
- b) The student must have completed 6th to matriculation total eight years out of ten years in a rural school whose annual fee is below Rs. 600/- per annum.

The scholarship will carry the name of the donor. The Accounts and economic background of the students will be open to scrutiny by the donors.

III College of Engineering (CoE), Punjabi University Neighbourhood Campus, Rampura Phul (Phul-Mehraj)

(a) Eligibility Criteria

Candidates, who have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and English subjects, will be admitted on the basis of their merit in CET-2009 conducted by Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar as per counseling schedule of CET-2009 at Jalandhar for all categories other than NRI category.

Admission of NRI candidates will be based on merit in 10+2 (Non-Medical) or equivalent examination. Candidates seeking admission under this category should contact the Head, College of Engineering, Rampura Phul for further details such as eligibility conditions, last date of application, procedure, counseling schedule etc.

b) Mode of Admission

Admission to all the B.Tech. course will be made from the categories described below

A) All India Basis: (15% Seats)

- 1) The candidates must have passed 10+2 (Non-Medical) examination from such a rural area school which does not fall under any Municipal Corporation/Municipal Committee/Small Town/Notified Area Committee.
- 2) The candidate must have been a student of the rural area school for at least eight years before the last examination passed.
- 3) The parents of the candidates must also be the residents of the village.

B) For Punjab State (Except for Rampura Phul Sub-Division) (50% of Remaining 85%)

- 1) The candidates must have passed 10+2 (Non-Medical) examination from such a rural area school, which does not fall under any Municipal Corporation/Municipal Committee/Small Town/Notified Area committee.
- 2) The candidate must have been a student of the rural area school for at least eight years before the last examination passed.
- 3) The parents of the candidates must also be the residents of the village.

C) For Punjab State (only for the Rampura Phul Sub-Division) (50% of Remaining 85%)

- 1) The candidates must have passed 10+2 (Non-Medical) examination from such a rural area school, which does not fall under any Municipal Corporation/Municipal Committee/Small Town/Notified Area committee. (For Rampura Phul Rural) and Rampura & Phul (For Rampura Phul Urban).
- 2) The candidate must have schooling eight years in a school situated at any place in Rampura Phul Sub-division as indicated in C(i).
- 3) The parents should be residing at any place in Rampura Phul Sub-division (in a village for rural seat and Rampura & Phul proper for Urban Seat).

D. Seats for students of Rampura Phul Urban area/Rampura Phul Rural Area would be in proportional to urban/rural population of the sub-division.

E. If seats are left vacant in any category then these seats should be transferred to the category of Rural students of Punjab as at "B" first and then to Urban residents of Punjab and finally to All India (Open). In every category there will be statutory reservation for SC/ST and BC or any other statutory reservation as applicable.
